# THE UNDERWRITER'S CORNER

FLEET SAFETY - A BRIEF OVERVIEW

It can happen in the blink of an eye, a motor vehicle accident (MVA) can forever change the lives of not only those directly involved, but many others as well. In workers' compensation, the events of a MVA are largely the same, however, there are additional issues that arise. For an employer, a MVA can bring about not only the emotional toll of a possible injured worker, but additional questions such as: Will my insurance rates go up? Will my policy be cancelled? Will the business face any fines?

In a 2006 comprehensive study conducted by the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI), researchers found that 1) MVAs are more severe than the average workers' compensation claim, 2) MVAs comprise a growing share of workers' compensation injuries, 3) MVA claims are more likely to be lost-time claims (i.e., more expensive), 4) average duration is more than 70% longer for MVAs 60 months after the injury date, and 5) MVAs are three times as likely to involve a claimant attorney than other claims.

In order to avoid the disruption caused by MVAs, it is important for entities with one or more company vehicles to implement a Fleet Safety Program. A Fleet Safety Program should consist of 1) Driver Selection Procedures, 2) Defensive Driving Training, 3) Vehicle Selection, Inspection and Maintenance Procedures, 4) Accident Investigation Procedures, 5) an Accident Review Board and 6) Evaluation of Driver


