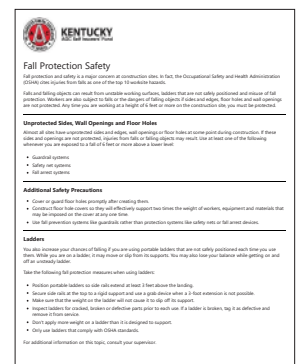
Training & Materials
